This is further to your correspondence of March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2011. I understand that Classroom Services provided your clients with the additional space that they requested. Classroom Services also exercised its discretion to accept the application for display space from Students for Reproductive Rights on short notice.

With respect to your concerns about your client's display being disrupted, the University was pleased that your client's event on March 10<sup>th</sup> was uneventful, and that all parties involved conducted themselves in an appropriate manner. Campus Security was on site throughout the day to assist both student groups to set up their displays, and to monitor the event. The University was prepared to intervene in the event of any inappropriate behaviour. As you are aware, prior to the event the University took steps to remind students of the University's expectations regarding their conduct.

The University looks forward to working with your clients and other student groups on future events.
