AFFIDAVIT OF B.B. Sworn on January 8, 2019

I, B.B.	, of the, in the Province of Alberta, SWEAR AND SAY THAT:
1.	I am a year-old boy, currently in grade I. I have personal knowledge of the facts herein deposed except where based on information and belief, in which case I verily believe same to be true.
Backg	<u>cround</u>
2.	I live with my mother and school for grades for grades. I began attending in grade .
Attend	ding the GSA
3.	has had a Gay Straight Alliance club ("GSA") for as long as have been attending the school.
4.	I began attending the GSA in March 2018 because a female friend of mine asked me to. At the time, I had six friends who were attending the GSA meetings. I knew very little about GSAs before I started attending.
5.	Students in grades 6-12 were allowed to attend the GSA meetings together. At the first GSA meeting I attended, there were about 12 students, including at least two students in grade 12 and at least three students in grade 6.
6.	The GSA met every Thursday and I continued to attend every week throughout April. Most of the time there were no adults present. Occasionally, the school's Family Wellness Worker was present.
The G	SA Conference
7.	At one of the GSA meetings in April, said there would be a "GSA Conference" on May 11, 2018. She did not say much about what would happen at the conference, only that we would "have fun" and that there would be a

- "surprise". said that anybody in grade 9 or older could attend, so I decided I would attend.
- 9. When I arrived at the Conference, I saw a few booths. The first booth I came to had a lot of condoms at it, a stack of postcards, and a pile of little books. I did not look closely at the little books at the time, but I received one of the little books in a bag that I was given as I was leaving the Conference.
- 10. I looked at the postcard that was at the booth. Written on the postcard (the "Uranus Postcard", attached to this affidavit as **Exhibit** "A") is "EXPLORE THE WONDERS OF URANUS". Below the writing is a picture of a spaceship in the shape of a penis and testicles and two moons right beside each other that look like buttocks. There is also an astronaut holding the rainbow flag. "HIV COMMUNITY LINK" is written in small letters in the bottom right-hand corner.
- 11. The little book, titled "Who's got the condom?" (the "Flipbook", attached to this affidavit as **Exhibit** "B"), is a cartoon flip book with about 50 pages, all images with no text. The Flipbook shows two naked males who both have erections. The older male puts on a condom, then appears to insert his penis inside the anus of the boy.
- 12. Students from four schools, including my school, attended the Conference. There were about 50 students present at the Conference.
- 13. In the afternoon, there was a "drag show" in which three adult "drag queens" (men dressed up as women) and one adult "drag king" (a woman dressed up as a man) put on a dance. The dance lasted for a few minutes, the length of two songs.
- 14. I learned that the "drag" dancers were from a "drag" group in Calgary. After the "drag show", I spoke with the "drag king". She asked how old I was. I told her I

- was years old. She invited me to come work with her for a day in Calgary if I was interested in "drag".
- 15. At the end of the Conference, as the students were leaving, we were all given blue pull-string bags (the "Blue Bag"). gave me my bag. She did not say what was in it.
- I opened the Blue Bag and took out everything in it as soon as I got home. I was surprised. In the Blue Bag was the Flipbook, a card from the Calgary Sexual Health Centre, a few pins, and a lot of condoms. Attached as Exhibit "C" to this affidavit is a picture of some of the condoms and the card from the Calgary Sexual Health Centre. I could not understand why there were so many condoms. I found it hard to believe that a teenager could have sex so much that they would ever need so many condoms. I also thought it was strange that we were given so many condoms, but that there was no discussion at the Conference about sexual activity, or about the risks of being sexually active.
- 17. I hid the Blue Bag from my mother. I did not know what she would think if she found it or how I would explain what was inside of it.

After the Conference

- 18. For two weeks following the Conference, I hid the Blue Bag from my mother and that I had attended the Conference.
- 19. Two weeks after the Conference, my mother found the Blue Bag while she was cleaning my room. She immediately talked to me about it. We talked for a long time. I told her everything. I was relieved to talk with her openly.
- I talked with my mother about sexual activity. She explained to me the risks that can come with having sex, whether with girls or boys. We discussed things such as STDs. I knew that condoms were supposed to protect people when having sex, but it was never explained to me by anybody at the GSA or the Conference the things that condoms do and do not protect people from, or the fact that condoms do not always work. I did not know the risks were so serious. I do not think I was given the knowledge I should have had regarding sexuality and sexual behavior. I am glad my mother has helped me to understand. Now that I know how serious

sex is, I want to wait until I am older, and better able to make good decisions, before I engage in sexual behavior with anyone.

Conclusion

the Province of Alberta

- 21. Looking back on everything, I am uncomfortable that the school kept secrets from my mother. I do not think that is right. I know that my mother loves me, and has my best interest at heart, and that it is best for me that she knows what is going on in my life.
- 22. I swear this Affidavit bona fide and for no improper purpose.


