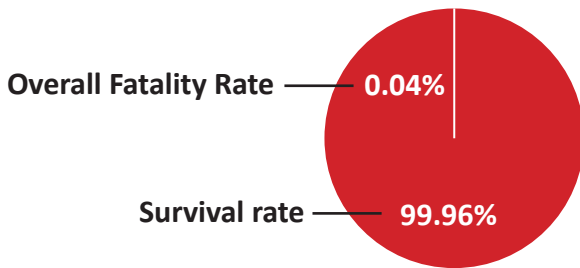

Deaths with Covid (Mortality Rate)



Fatality Rates = Based on 422 Deaths

Overall Fatality Rate = 0.04% (422/1,177,884)

Survival Rate = 99.96% ($\{1,177,884-422\}/1,177,884$)

Case Fatality Rate = 1.37% (422/{32,346-1,623})

Infection Fatality Rate = Not enough data to provide

% positive = **5.03%** (32,346/643,629)

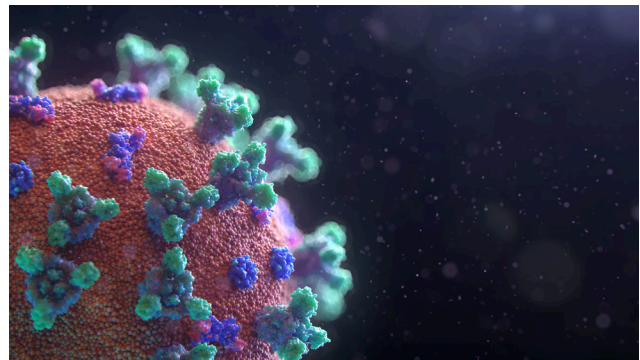
% negative = **94.97%** ($\{643,629-32,346\}/643,629$)

Definitions

Case Fatality Rate - considers deaths versus resolved cases. Calculate by taking total deaths divided by {total positive PCR tests and probable cases (minus current unresolved cases)}(tested and probable).

Infection Fatality Rate - total deaths/estimated total confirmed/unconfirmed.

Overall Fatality Rate - total deaths with Covid/Total population (also called Mortality Rate).
