



Definitions

Case Survival Rate - considers people who did not die versus resolved cases. Calculate by taking total non-deaths divided by {total positive PCR tests and probable cases (minus current unresolved cases}(tested and probable).

Infection Survival Rate - total non-deaths/estimated total confirmed and unconfirmed.

Overall Fatality Rate - Total deaths with Covid/Total population (also called Mortality Rate).
