

## Re: Sheila Annette Lewis v Alberta Health Services, et al

We are in receipt of your correspondence dated April 14, 2023.

As has been previously advised, although a policy was created at the time of Ms. Paulson's crossexamination, it had not been enacted, and was not in place at that time. It remains the case as of the date of this letter that no formal AHS policy is in place relating to the vaccination of transplant patients. Should a policy be put in place by AHS, we ensure that you are provided with a copy at that time.

As the decision about Ms. Lewis's status on the Transplant List is a decision made by her treating physicians in the Transplant Program, AHS has no reply to any of the further requests in your correspondence.
