

THIS COURT ORDERS that:


1. The plaintiffs' application under Rule 13-1(14) to review and amend the order settled by Registrar Gaily is dismissed.

2. The Province is entitled to its costs of this application in the cause. If the Province is not ultimately successful in the action, then each party will bear their own costs of this application.


