Re: LERA Complaint No. 2026/43

Thank you for the email of May 22, 2026, making application for a review of the commissioner's decision by a Provincial Court Judge.

As required by section 13(3) of The Law Enforcement Review Act (the act), I have forwarded your application to the Chief Judge of the Provincial Court of Manitoba so a Provincial Court Judge may be assigned to conduct the requested review.

Our office works closely with court administration to facilitate a date to proceed with your complaint. Accordingly, in order to facilitate this matter, your attendance is required before a Provincial Court Judge on **Wednesday, June 24, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. in Room 401 of the Law Courts Complex at 408 York Avenue, Winnipeg.**

You should be present at that time to set a review date. If you have retained a lawyer, your lawyer may appear for you. If you anticipate seeking advice from a lawyer, please do so prior to the date stated above. If you fail to appear, it is possible that your complaint may be dismissed at the request of the Respondent(s).

The presiding Provincial Court Judge will explain how the matter is to proceed when your case is called.

For your guidance, following are the sections of (the act) relevant to a review application:

Procedure on application

13(3) On receiving an application under subsection (2), the Commissioner shall refer the complaint to a provincial judge who, after hearing any submissions from the parties in support of or in opposition to the application, and if satisfied that the Commissioner erred in declining to take further action on the complaint, shall order the Commissioner

(a) to refer the complaint for a hearing; or

(b) to take such other action under this Act respecting the complaint as the Provincial Court Judge directs.

Burden of Proof on Complainant

13(4) Where an application is brought under subsection (2), the burden of proof is on the complainant to show that the Commissioner erred in declining to take further action on the complaint

To assist in preparing for the review, I have enclosed a copy of your file.
