Dear Ms. Pejovic:

On behalf of the South East Cornerstone Public School Division (the “**Division**”), I am writing in response to your correspondence dated May 26, 2026, regarding the use of washroom facilities at the Lampman School.

Given our privacy obligations to all students, we cannot disclose personal information or otherwise engage in a discussion that could identify a student’s individual circumstances. Accordingly, the Division will not respond to allegations or assertions concerning any identifiable student, including any student’s personal characteristics, conduct, or use of school facilities. That said, specific safety or conduct concerns that are brought to the attention of school administration are reviewed and addressed through appropriate school processes. In doing so, the Division must consider and balance its obligations to all students, including obligations relating to safety, privacy, and non-discrimination.

To this end, the Division acknowledges the concerns raised in your correspondence regarding the privacy, comfort and well-being of other students when using school washroom facilities.

The Division believes that all students have the right to learn and interact in a safe and caring environment, and is committed to creating and maintaining school community environments where all people are treated with dignity and respect. Each school in the Division provides male, female and gender-neutral washroom facilities for student use.

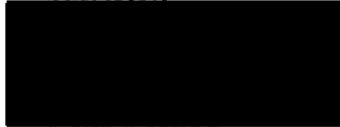
Lampman School currently has several gendered, multi-stall bathrooms located throughout the School (including washrooms for kindergarten to grade 5, grade 6 to 12, and washrooms by the gym). At the time of your correspondence, Lampman School also had a single-stall gender-neutral washroom available for students to use.

To address the concerns you have raised in your correspondence, and to accommodate both student/parent choice and for any student that desires increased privacy, Lampman School has created three additional single-stall gender-neutral washrooms available for student use. In

total, there will now be four single-stall washrooms that will be available to any students who wish to use them, including students who may prefer additional privacy.

These steps have been taken to respond to the concerns raised in your correspondence, and are in line with the Division's responsibilities to respect the privacy of all students. The Division will continue to monitor the matter and will address any specific operational concerns as they arise, consistent with its legal obligations and its responsibility to provide a safe, respectful, and inclusive school environment.
